ENTRY FEE: \$25 per shooter by Oct.17 (telephone entries, or e-mail entries OK) Juniors \$10

POST ENTRY: Accepted to range capacity of 40 shooters.

CANCELLATIONS: No penalty, refunded in full. Please be courteous and call so we can give your slot to someone else.

JUNIORS: \$10 Entry Fee.

CLASSIFICATIONS: NRA Classification system will be used. Unclassified shooters will compete as Masters, subject to Rule 19.6.

RIFLE: Any 22 as defined in rule 3.2.

SIGHTS: Any

TARGETS: Standard for conventional prone (A-23, A-26, A-25)

TARGET CHANGING: Shooters will hang their unfired targets but will not handle their fired targets.

TARGET CLIPS: Must be supplied by competitor.

RANGE FACILITIES: The range has a clubhouse, covered firing line, paved points, water, restrooms, refrigerator. A light lunch of drinks, hot dogs, chips, and coffee will be available at modest cost.

FIRING POINTS: We will assign your relay. When you sign in you will draw your point from a jar with numbers in it, hence a sort of random point assignment.

MATCH SCHEDULES: Firing starts at 8:30 am. Match 1 Dewar (20 shots at 50 yds. And 20 shots a 100 yds.), Match 2 (40 shots at 100 yds.), Match 3 (40 shots at 50 meters), Match 4-Aggregate 1200.

AWARDS: FOR THE AGGREGATE ONLY! Engraved plaque to match winner. Engraved medals to all first-in-class winners if minimum of three shooters in class. Additional award of plaques or medals for every five competitors or fraction thereafter in class (e.g., 3=one award, 4-8=two awards, 9-13= three awards, etc.) Depending on entries we may give award points in lieu of medals.

IRON SIGHTS: A medal to the high Iron Sights regardless of class. Second place iron if more than five shooters.

Please tell us if you are Iron, Lefty, or a Junior.

We can always use volunteers for scoring, squadding, line officer, etc.
